Firefighter Cullinane was first appointed to the Department on April 16, 1944 while in the armed services of his country, and

WHEREAS:

Firefighter Cullinane's active fire duty began on March 5, 1946 being assigned to Engine 1 until 1947 at which time he was assigned to the Rescue Company for a period of five years until he received his last assignment to Ladder Company 2 on Portland Street on October 25, 1952, an assignment he had until his death, and

WHEREAS:

John E. Cullinane had completed 29 years of active duty in behalf of the many thousands of residents in our community, always putting the lives of others ahead of his own, now therefore be it

That this City Council go on record extending our deepest sorrow to the wife and family of the late John E. Cullinane at their great loss, and be it further

RESOLVED:

That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to Mrs. Cullinane as a remembrance of her late husband by this City Council.
