To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$158,400.00 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services Salaries & Wages Account (\$104,369.00), Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$53,231.00) and Travel and Training Account (\$800.00) from the Massachusetts Department of Housing and Community Development. The Homelessness Intercept Program was created when the State combined the Housing Search Program and the Housing Services Program. These funds are to be used to prevent homelessness by providing counseling for tenants, counseling for landlords, mediation for disputes between tenants and landlords and housing search assistance for families facing eviction. The funds will be used for staff salaries and benefits, program operating costs and trainings.
