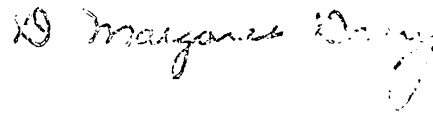

- WHEREAS: Hugh was a practicing architect for more than sixty years who received his Bachelor of Architecture Degree from the Georgia Institute of Technology and a Masters of Architecture Degree from Harvard Graduate School of Design; and
- WHEREAS: Hugh was a faculty member of the Harvard Graduate School of Design, assuming Chairmanship of the Department of Architecture in 1953; and
- WHEREAS: Hugh was a Fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences and Academician of the National Academy of Design; and
- WHEREAS: Hugh received a Gold Medal for Excellence in Design from Tau Sigma Delta, the National Honorary Fraternity for Architecture and Allied Arts; and
- WHEREAS: Some of Hugh's notable designs are the Berlin Congress Hall, the City Corps Center in New York, the Federal Reserve Bank of Boston and the Landmark Tower in Japan; and
- WHEREAS: Hugh's passing will leave a void in the lives of all his surviving family, his children Patricia Minot and Peter, Hugh III and Michael Stubbins; and his grandchildren Adam, Kurt, Alexandra, Christopher and Samuel Stubbins, Diana Reilly and Peter, Judith and Benjamin Minot; and
