- WHEREAS:** The vitality of our nation flows from our recognition of and respect for equality among persons; and
- WHEREAS:** The 18th anniversary of the National Fair Housing Law, Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968 is commemorated during the month of April, 1986; and
- WHEREAS:** This anniversary is an occasion for all Americans to renew their dedication to equality among persons and the freedom which flows therefrom in the matter of choice of housing; and
- WHEREAS:** Equality and freedom are indivisible, such that when they are diminished in one place, they are diminished in all places; and
- WHEREAS:** Equality and freedom in the choice of housing constitute the policy of the City of Cambridge; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED:** That this City Council proclaim April, 1986 as Fair Housing Month in Cambridge, and call upon the people of Cambridge to reaffirm and rededicate themselves to the American promise of individual equality and fair housing freedom of choice; and be it further
- RESOLVED:** That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Samuel R. Pierce, Jr., the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development.
