The City of Cambridge is responsible for protecting its residents from such unsafe and hazardous conditions in order to provide their public health, safety and welfare, and

WHEREAS:

The City Council and private citizens have brought examples of unsafe and unsecured properties to the attention of the City Manager, and

WHEREAS:

The Council has requested information concerning the administrative process in dealing with abandoned and unsafe buildings but has received no communication, therefore be it

ORDERED:

That the City Clerk call a public hearing on this issue on Monday, April 12, at 8:00 P. M., and be it further

ORDERED:

That the Superintendent of Buildings, Board of Survey, Public Works Commissioner, and Chief Housing Inspector be requested to attend.
