ORDERED, That due notice be given to the abutters on said Sidney, Henry and Albany streets and Fairmont avenue, between the points above mentioned, and all other persons interested, that this Board intends to lay out the streets before mentioned, by taking a portion of their land and laying out the same as public streets, in accordance with plans on file in the office of the City Engineer; and that

is assigned as the time for hearing any objections which may be made thereto.
