To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$24,769.00 in the grant fund of the Department of Human Services Programs' Office of Workforce Development's Other Ordinary Maintenance Account. The Massachusetts' Office of School-to-Work Transition has awarded the Office of Workforce Development funding through the Bunker Hill Community College. The grant will be used to enhance emerging School-to-Work initiatives in Cambridge and to plan and implement a year-round career pathways system through engaging local employers, the public schools and local community based organizations. The program will serve school aged youth from diverse backgrounds as well as low and moderate income groups. Funds will be used to subcontract with local non-profits and for coordination through Office of Workforce Development.
