- WHEREAS: The Immaculate Conception Church located at 432 Windsor Street, Cambridge, observed its Diamond Jubilee on Saturday, December 8th, 1984 with a pontifical concelebrated Mass at the Church; and
- WHEREAS: The principal celebrant and homilist of the Mass was His Excellency Paulius F. Baltakis D.D., O.F.M., Bishop for Spiritual Needs to Lithuanian Catholics outside of Lithuania; and
- WHEREAS: The Immaculate Conception Lithuanian Church was founded in 1909 under the spiritual leadership of Father Joseph Krasnickas, its first Pastor and saw it consecrated by Auxiliary Bishop Anderson, which occurred after the late William Cardinal O'Connell permitted a delegation of over two hundred families to begin the parish; and
- WHEREAS: Throughout the early years of its founding the Church began to grow and the numbers of parishioners began to expand, and in 1966, upon the transfer of Father Baltruskunas to St. Peter's Church, South Boston, Father Simeon Saulenas was appointed Pastor, and among other things he did for the parish, he was successful in receiving Archdiocesan approval to build a new rectory and refurbished the upper Church; and
- WHEREAS: This Diamond Jubilee also coincides with Father Saulenas's Fortieth Anniversary in the priesthood, an event which is a very personal and rewarding experience in his life; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere best wishes and congratulations to Father Simeon Saulenas and the entire parish of the Immaculate Conception Lithuanian Church on this happy occasion; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Father Saulenas on behalf of the entire City Council.
