WHEREAS: Hundreds of Cambridge Rindge and Latin School students have received scholarships at the Harvard Extension School under the Community-Based Learning and Lowell Scholarship programs developed by **Dean Michael Shinagel**; and

WHEREAS: Scores of Cambridge City employees have been awarded the Leonard J. Russell Scholarship for studies in administration and management in a program developed by **Dean Michael Shinagel** and the City of Cambridge; and

WHEREAS: Hundreds of thousands of Extension and Summer School students from Greater Boston, New England, the fifty states of the U.S., and more than eighty-five foreign countries have improved the quality of their lives and contributed many millions of dollars to the economy of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts during the tenure of **Dean Michael Shinagel**; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the citizens and City of Cambridge salute a great educator and devoted neighbor.

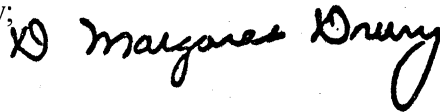
