COUNCILLOR WALSH

- WHEREAS: There have been numerous complaints regarding the issue of traffic safety for students of the Longfellow School; and
- WHEREAS: From the perspective of elementary school children, pedestrians, as well as the operators of vehicles, traffic conditions on Broadway between Lee and Inman Streets are extremely hazardous; and
- WHEREAS: There is not only an absence of sufficient and appropriate lights to control traffic and protect the students, but there is also a lamentable lack of clearly visible signs to alert drivers that they are near a school and speed must be reduced; now therefor be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager is hereby requested to have the Commissioner of Traffic and Parking survey the traffic situation proximate to the Longfellow School and arrange for the installation of flashing lights, button activated walklights, additional signs or any other remedial measure which in his professional judgment would be of assistance.
