Ordered,

That the Committee on Roads and
Bridges be, and they is, authorized and
instructed to make the necessary arrange-
ments for procuring a ferry-boat for the
transportation of foot-passengers between
Ward Three and the City of Boston, where
Craig's Bridge is undergoing repairs, and
to place the necessary steps and floats
in either side of the river, well paved
to present a safe place to pass by
those crossing in said boat.

West Boston and Craig's Bridge.
