

City of Cambridge.

In Board of Aldermen, October 10th 1871

Whereas, It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that First Street from Cambridge Street to Otis Street should be laid out as a public Street.

Ordered, That a strip of land fifty feet in width, between Cambridge and Otis Street included between the red lines as shown on a plan drawn by J. G. Chase City Engineer and dated July 17th 1871 and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street. Ordered that no damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid.
