PART TWO.

Effective July 1, 1974, all positions described in Part One shall, if applicable, receive an additional wage increase computed as follows:

For the purpose of computing any such increase the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics, Consumer Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers - Greater Boston Area for January, 1973, shall be considered to be the base index. The increase, if any, shall be computed by subtracting the base index from the index for July, 1974. That difference shall then be multiplied by 100. That product will be divided by the base index. The division shall, if necessary, be carried to the nearest hundredth and then rounded off to the nearest tenth. Hundredths up to and including four hundredths shall be considered zero tenths and five hundredths and above shall be considered to be one-tenth for the purpose of rounding off.

All persons holding the above positions at the time of the passage of this ordinance shall receive their salaries then in effect plus the salary adjustment equivalent to 6 per cent of such salaries.

Persons appointed to these positions after the passage of this ordinance shall receive a minimum salary with an increment each year of their service until the maximum annual salary is reached.

To the Honorable, the City Council:

Enclosed for your approval is an amendment to the Department Head Salary Ordinance which provides for an annual increase of \$1,200, effective January 1, 1977, for department heads, with the exception of the City Manager and Assistant City Managers. Those employees not covered by this ordinance whose salaries are over \$20,000 and thus did not receive 6% on July 1, 1976, will receive the same increase, with the exception of the medical personnel at the Hospital and the employees of the Community Development Department.

The employees receiving this increase have not had an increase since July 1, 1974, and it is felt that this is an equitable adjustment.
