

Beginning at a point in the division line between land of President and Fellows of Harvard College and land of the City of Cambridge, said point being in the easterly boundary line of Holmes Place, so called, ten and fifteen hundredths (10.15) feet northerly from the northerly line of Cambridge St., thence northwesterly parallel to and ten (10) feet distant, northeasterly from the present northeasterly line of Cambridge St. three hundred fifty-one and six hundredths (351.06) feet to the tangent point of a curve, thence again northwesterly along a curve of sixty (60) feet radius, twenty-one and fifty-five hundredths (21.55) feet to a corner in the northerly boundary line of Holmes Place so called, near its junction with the easterly line of Mass. Ave., thence easterly along a curve of eight (8) feet radius, three and ninety-seven hundredths (3.97) feet to its tangent point in the division line between land of the City of Cambridge and land of President and Fellows of Harvard College, said point being in the northerly line of Holmes Place, so called, thence easterly along the said division line, two hundred forty and three tenths (240.3) feet to a corner, thence southerly along the division line between land of President and Fellows of Harvard College and land of the City of Cambridge, said line being the easterly boundary line of Holmes Place, so called, first above mentioned, two hundred fifty-three and ninety-two hundredths (253.92) feet to the point of beginning. Containing thirty-one thousand three hundred fifty-five and four tenths square feet, (31,355.4).

ORDERED:-

That His Honor the Mayor be and hereby is authorized to execute a deed in the name and behalf of the City of Cambridge conveying to the President and Fellows of Harvard College a certain parcel of land in Cambridge bounded and described as follows:-

Beginning at a point in the division line between land of President and Fellows of Harvard College and land of the City of Cambridge, said point being in the easterly boundary line of Holmes Place, so-called, ten and fifteen hundredths (10.15) feet northerly from the northerly line of Cambridge Street, thence northwesterly parallel to and ten (10) feet distant, northeasterly from the present northeasterly line of Cambridge Street, three hundred fifty-one and six hundredths (351.06) feet to the tangent point of a curve, thence again northwesterly along a curve of sixty (60) feet radius, twenty-one and fifty-five hundredths (21.55) feet to a corner in the northerly boundary line of Holmes Place so-called, near its junction with the easterly line of Mass. Ave., thence easterly along a curve of eight (8) feet radius, three and ninety-seven hundredths (3.97) feet to its tangent point in the division line between land of the City of Cambridge and land of President and Fellows of Harvard College, said point being in the northerly line of Holmes Place, so-called, thence easterly along the said division line, two hundred forty and three tenths (240.3) feet to a corner, thence southerly along the division line between land of President and Fellows of Harvard College and land of the City of Cambridge, said line being the easterly boundary line of Holmes Place,

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so-called, first above mentioned, two hundred fifty-three and ninety-two hundredths (253.92) feet to the point of beginning. Containing thirty-one thousand three hundred fifty-five and four tenths (31,355.4) square feet.

The above described parcel is shown on a plan entitled: "Plan of land in Cambridge belonging to the City of Cambridge" dated July 15, 1929, drawn by L. M. Hastings, City Engineer and on file in the office of the said City Engineer of Cambridge, Mass.

The consideration for said deed is the conveyance to the City of Cambridge by the President and Fellows of Harvard College of a certain parcel of land in Cambridge bounded by Cambridge Street, Broadway and Quincy Street.
