- WHEREAS: Massachusetts Institute of Technology is one of the largest employers in Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: Many of the employees at MIT are Cambridge residents; and
- WHEREAS: MIT's workers are covered by a pension plan so that they can live with dignity during their retirement years; and
- WHEREAS: MIT is unilaterally and indefensibly terminating the right of food service workers in the MIT dining halls and Faculty Club to continue to build their pension benefits and is therefore lowering the standard of living of retired residents of our City; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council supports the MIT Food Service Workers and their union, Local 26, in their struggle to protect the rights of food service workers to an uninterrupted MIT pension and a just retirement.
