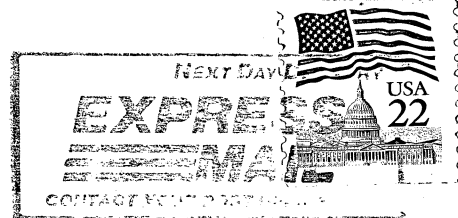

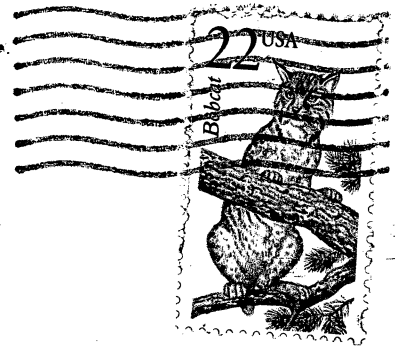

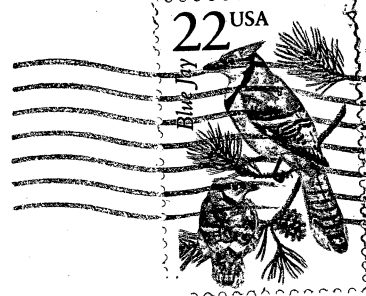

Dear City Council Members:


Congratulations! You people are without doubt the pioneers in the fight to take control of the deadly and despicable practice of using and abusing animals in the name of science.
