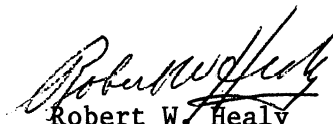

To the Honorable, the City Council:

This is to inform the City Council that legislation has been signed by the Governor that allows Cambridge to send out estimated tax bills pending completion of the revaluation program. Estimated tax bills, representing fifty percent of last year's net tax, will be sent to all property owners on Monday and Tuesday of this week. The tax bills which are not voluntary are due on November 1, 1986. The actual tax bill which will be sent in the Spring of 1986 will reflect State-approved assessments and credit for payments made on the estimated tax.
