NCN Communications, Inc. ("NCN" or "Company"), an Arizona Corporation seeks permission from the Department to provide interexchange telephone service within Massachusetts. NCN proposes to offer telephone services, including operator services to customers. The Company has also filed a proposed tariff of rates and charges for its services. The tariff is being investigated by the Department in docket D.P.U. 90-69.

Application of NCN Communications, Inc., under the provisions of Chapter 159 of the General Laws as amended, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a resale, value-added or interexchange common carrier within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

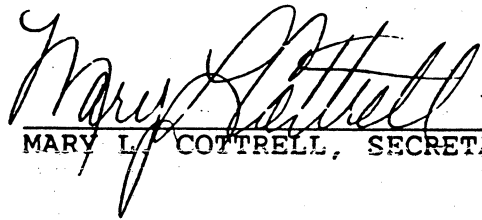
