Dear Mr. Sullivan,

In regard to City Council Order No. 10 dated April 1, 1974, I wish to inform you that a Flashing Yellow Warning Beacon was installed at the intersection of Walden Street and Hubbard Avenue on April 15, 1974. It is our opinion that an overhead warning beacon is a more efficient type of warning device and also our experience with lighted arrows is that the cost of replacing them due to vandalism is tremendous.

As for City Council Order Numbers 11, ^(4/1/74) all signs leading to the Walden Street Bridge have been installed at the intersections requested by the City Council.

4/1/74 As I reported to the City Council on City Council Order Number 13 on the problems of Rindge Avenue, created by the fact that the Alewife Brook Bridges on both sides of Rindge Avenue, have been restricted to any vehicle over eight (8) tons. The City of Cambridge has requested the State to expedite the shoring up of these bridges to allow heavy trucking and I have talked to the Fire Chief to make some arrangements in getting our fire apparatus or the adjoining community's cooperation in fighting fires in North Cambridge.

A meeting was also held with the Chief of Police to enforce the Load Limit restrictions on the Walden Street and Huron Avenue bridges which are limited to six (6) tons and legally posted.

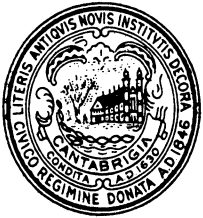

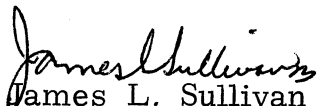
