That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Director of Traffic and Parking to make the necessary arrangements with the Chief of Police and the Chief of the Fire Department to close Palmer Street to vehicular traffic on Saturday, September 27, 1980 from 10 a. m. to 5 p. m. for the purpose of enabling the Harvard Cooperative Society to expand its weekly Sidewalk Sale to include a street book and arts festival; this permit is granted subject to the condition that adequate fire lanes will be kept available during this period for the safety of the public.
