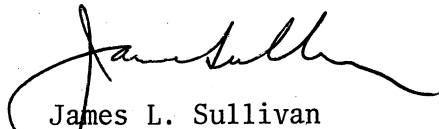

To the Honorable, the City Council:

In response to Council Order No. 15 of May 3, 1976, relative to the continuance of bus service on the Harvard Square - Kendall Square Line via Broadway, please be advised that we have been assured by representatives of the MBTA that this route will not be discontinued. There will, however, be a decrease in rush hour service with a change in frequency from 15 minutes to 30 minutes. This change is one of several service reductions to be made in Cambridge and the rest of the system within the MBTA District. Cambridge is not being singled out in this economy move, but is being treated on equal terms with the rest of the system.
