The Cambridge Public Library, 449 Broadway, has made available an exhibit case in its lobby from January 16th to January 31st. We have mounted a display designed to aid and encourage our current effort to recycle paper, glass, aluminum, and high-density plastics, and to draw more citizens from across the city to participate in our effort.

Our second interest is to add more material on environmental issues to the library's collection in a space provided through the support of Paul Depta and Ron Brown of the Cambridge Public Library. This space on the Reference Shelves will have an evolving collection on many environmental issues presently confronting cities and states.
