WHEREAS: The School Department's response to my Council Order of February 26, 1990 concerning specific inquiry into various data on the 766 Program left some areas less than fully clear relative to certain specifics; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager request the Superintendent of Schools to provide the following clarification with regard to present participants in the 766 Program: the total number of students over 18 years old; the total number of students under 5 years old; how many present participants have presented notarized documentation in proof that they are subject to the legal custody of a person who is an authentic full time Cambridge resident and presently living with that person at that referenced address; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager provide this additional data to this Council within one week.
