WHEREAS: This City Council is in receipt of a communication from Savvas Alexandridis, Parish President and Festival Chairman, and the Reverend Asterios Gerostergios, Parish Priest, Saints Constantine and Helen Greek Orthodox Church, relative to its three day Annual Grecian Cultural Festival to be held on Friday, Saturday and Sunday, August 21, 22 and 23, 1987 on the Church grounds at 14 Magazine Street, Cambridge; and

WHEREAS: Said communication requests permission to erect a sign on the lawn at City Hall for the purpose of announcing this year's Festival; said sign to be placed on the City Hall lawn about a month preceeding the event, from approximately July 20-August 23, 1987; and also for permission to close Magazine Street between Franklin and Auburn Streets from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. during the Festival; therefore be it

ORDERED: That this City Council go on record granting permission for the above requests to the Saints Constantine and Helen Greek Orthodox Church, with the provision that during the period of the street closing a fire land be provided and left open for the Fire Department and any other emergency vehicles; and be it further

ORDERED: That this City Council go on record granting permission to the Saints Constantine and Helen Church for the display of a car for the sale of raffle tickets; said vehicle to be displayed alternately in one of the parking spaces in front of City Hall, in front of the Cambridgeport Bank at Temple Street and Massachusetts Avenue and at the Twin Cities Mall, and that the Director of Traffic and Parking be requested to take the necessary steps as appropriate to cover the traffic meter in front of the car; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Commissioner of Public Works to confer with the petitioner, relative to the dates the car will be displayed at the above-referenced locations and also with regard to the erection of the sign on the front lawn of City Hall.

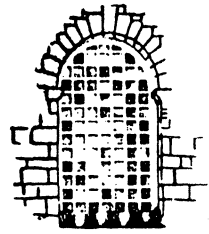

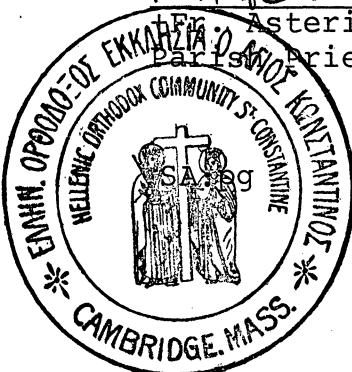
