- WHEREAS: The North Cambridge Health Center provides access to high quality primary health care services, including medical, pediatrics, obstetrics/gynecology, and mental health services, for residents of North Cambridge and surrounding neighborhoods; and
- WHEREAS: The North Cambridge Health Center, as one of six neighborhood health centers licensed and operated by The Cambridge Hospital, also offers the back-up of a full service hospital; and
- WHEREAS: The North Cambridge Health Center is staffed by a health team, including nurse practitioners, physicians, social workers, mental health professionals, and administrative and clinical support staff, which is dedicated to serving the community; and
- WHEREAS: The establishment of the new North Cambridge Health Center is a collaborative project of a number of agencies within the City of Cambridge, including the Department of Health and Hospitals, the Cambridge Housing Authority, and the Cambridge Community Development Department, and very much supported by the Health Policy Committee of the Hospital; and
- WHEREAS: The opening of the new North Cambridge Health Center at 266 Rindge Avenue is the result of the hard work, effort, and dreams of many people; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council hereby commends the many individuals involved in the planning of the new North Cambridge Health Center and its day to day operation for their contribution to improving the health status of the residents of the City of Cambridge; and further be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to be presented at the opening of the new center on June 21, 1990.

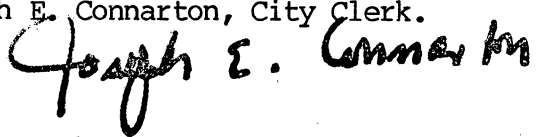
