Your Committee are of opinion
that suitable accommodations can be

less sum than the interest or the cost of
buildings and land;— more especially as it
is not probable that so many horses will be
needed for the ensuing season as have
heretofore been maintained by the city.

Your Committee are therefore unanimously
of opinion, that it is inexpedient for
the city to erect stables for their teams
at this time.
