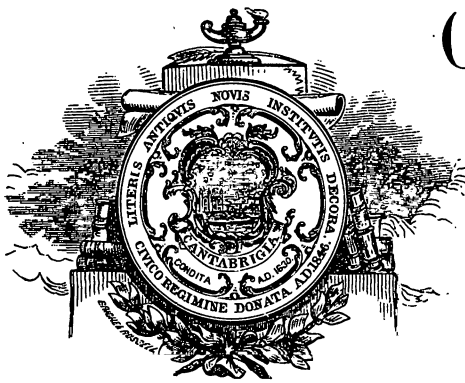




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

Nov. 9, 1874

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Lakeview Avenue

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *fifty feet* in width between

Grattle St. and Vassal Lane.

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by

W. S. Barbour and A. Hodges
dated Sept. 1874

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid. *And*
that thirty days be allowed for removal of all
obstructions standing thereon —
