IN CITY COUNCIL

May 15, 1995

ORDERED: That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Central Square World's Fair for the erection of four banners across Massachusetts Avenue at City Hall, Hi-Fi Pizza, Prospect Street and across Prospect Street, Cambridge, Massachusetts.

Provided that, before erecting the above named banners, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Inspectional Services Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000.) Dollars, conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said banners.

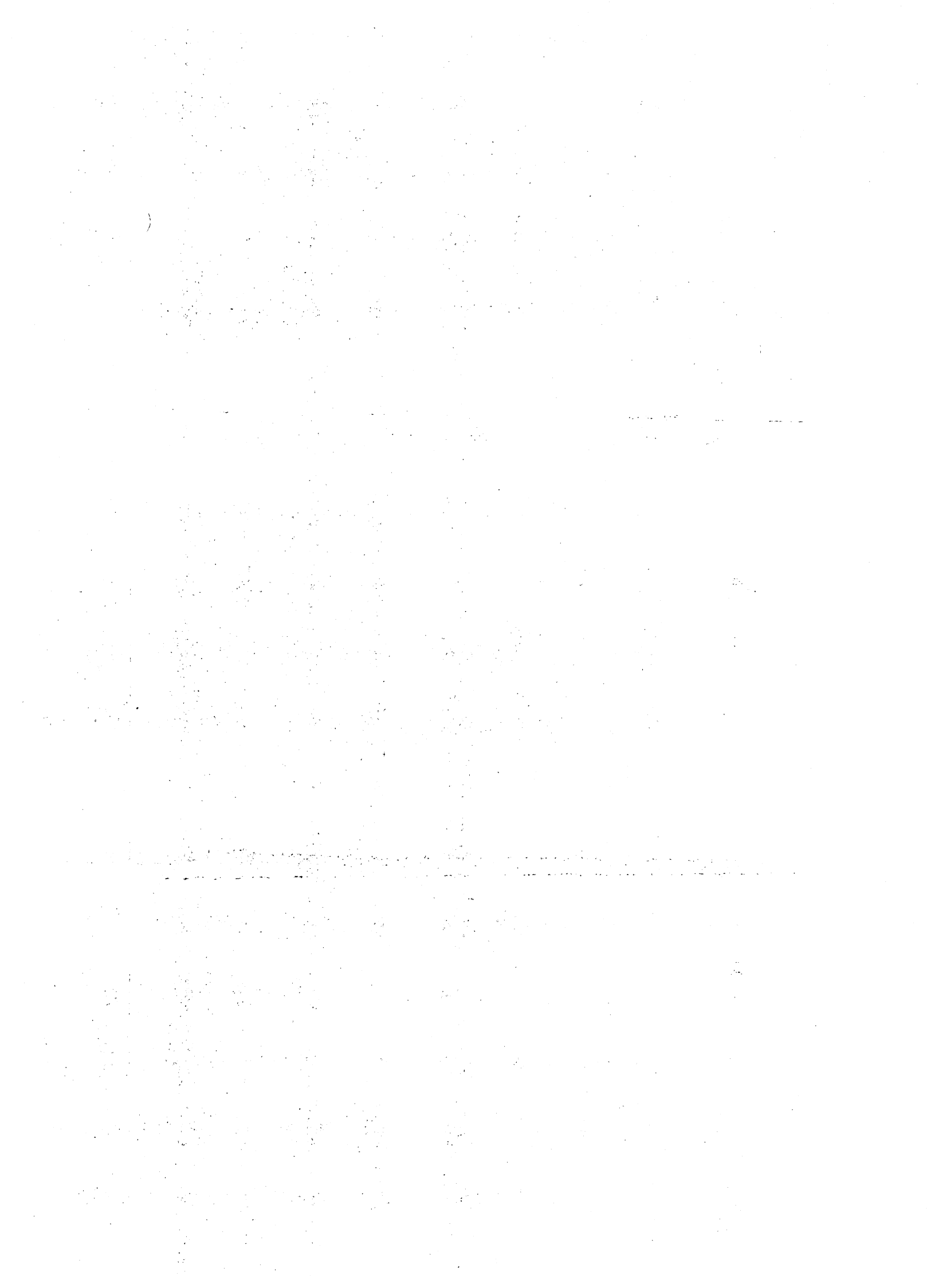

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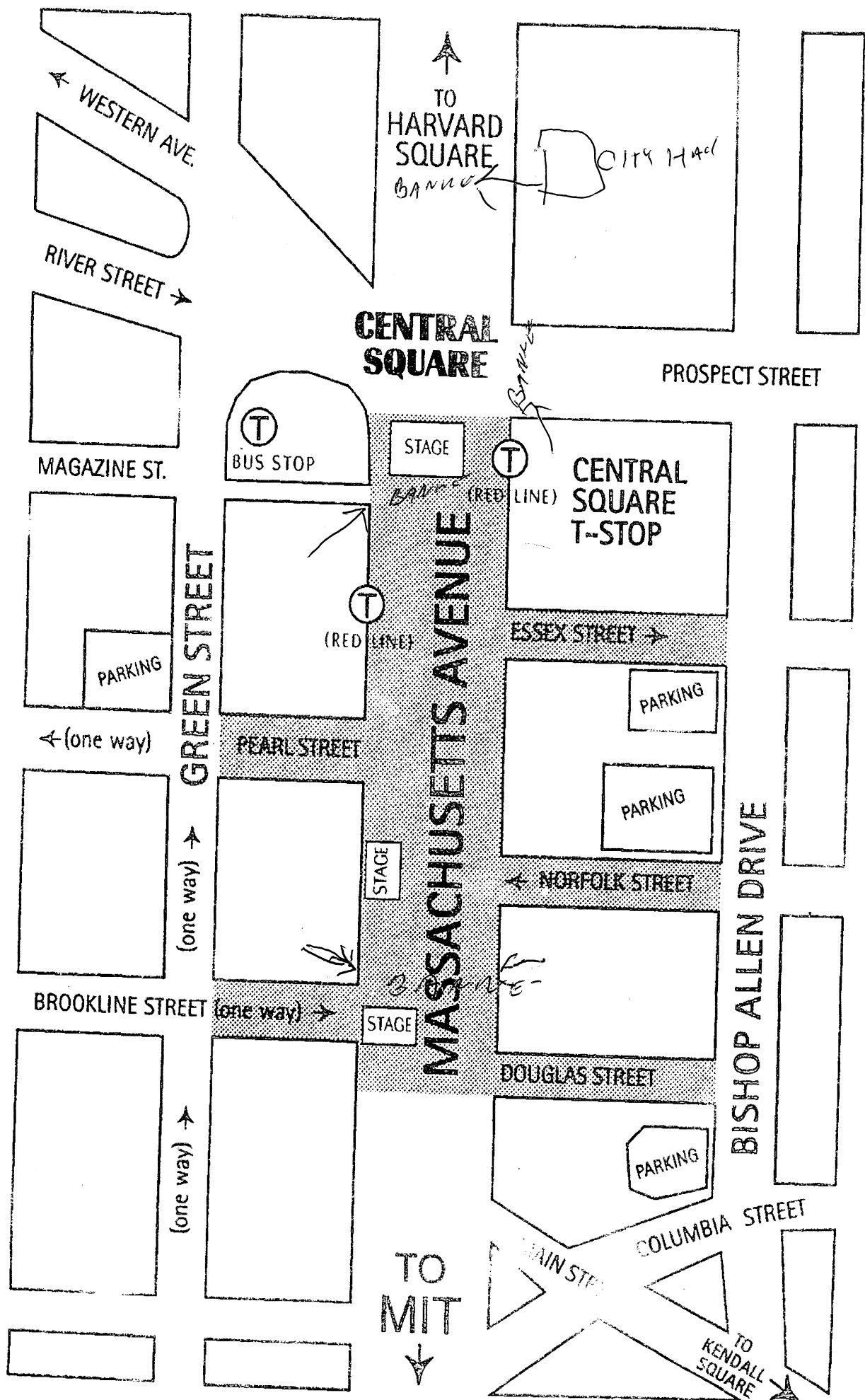
