- WHEREAS: It has been reported that the so-called acid sludge from the W. R. Grace Properties is to be moved from Cambridge this week to a dump site as part of the Red Line Extension project; and
- WHEREAS: This special waste material has supposedly been treated so that in its present form it is not dangerous; and
- WHEREAS: Even so, the City Council and the citizens of Cambridge deserve assurance as to the safety of this material as well as the process of moving it; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to instruct City Departments to issue no permits for its removal, as well as the MBTA and its contractors to take no steps for its removal until a report of the safety of said removal is first determined; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to file such a report with the City Council at its next regularly scheduled meeting.
