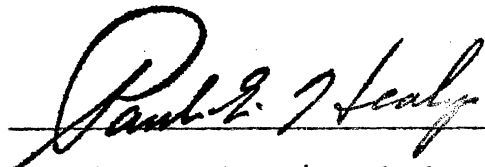
COUNCILLOR VELLUCCI
