- WHEREAS: The 21st Anniversary of the National Fair Housing Law, Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968 is commemorated during the month of April, 1989; and
- WHEREAS: This Anniversary should serve as a reminder that the government of the City of Cambridge should be ever vigilant in their commitment to fulfilling the American promise of individual equality and freedom of choice in choosing housing; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That I, Alfred E. Vellucci hereby proclaim the month of April, 1989 as FAIR HOUSING MONTH in Cambridge. I urge all residents of Cambridge to take cognizance of this event and do all they can to encourage and promote fair housing opportunities through legislation and personal action; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this Resolution to: Mr. Benjamin Little, Office of Fair Housing, Department of Housing and Urban Development
