The Engineers for the city of Cambridge, Public Works Department have contacted the owners of 66-68 Holworthy Street to discuss their complaints on the sidewalks.

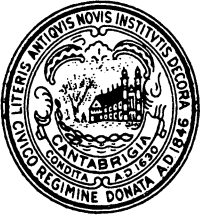
Upon inspection, it was discovered that the portion of the sidewalk in front of #66 is broken up and may have been caused by the recent construction. However, at 68 Holworthy Street, the bituminous concrete is broken up, but the condition is due to trees whose roots are bringing up the sidewalk.

Please be advised that these sidewalks will be repaired by both the Contractor and the Public Works Department.
