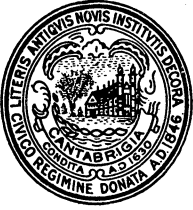

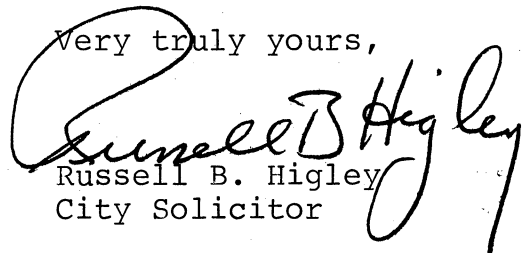
Re: Smoke Detectors

Dear Mr. Healy:

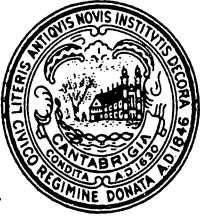
On September 15, 1980, the City Council accepted St. 1977, c.962, which amended G.L.c. 148, §26C to provide that smoke detectors must be installed in apartment houses containing six or more dwelling units.

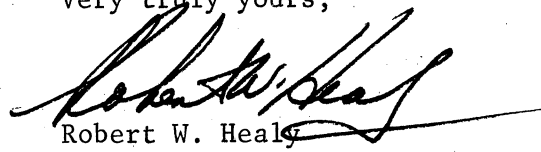
