To the Honorable, the City Council,


In response to neighborhood concern relative to the recreational needs of the Harrington School area, in particular, the closing of the X-ploration X-plosion Center, and the Newtowne Court Preteen Center in Area IV, the City Manager's Committee on Leisure Services and Recreational Planning has been meeting to assist in formulating plans for cooperative programming for the area and to identify available staff and resources that potentially might be available from within the agencies represented on the Committee.

The Committee was formed by me in August of this year with the charge of developing alternatives to the existing method of delivering recreational services. The Committee is composed of the directors of the Recreation Department, Community Schools, Youth Resources Bureau and the Public Library (Chairman).

I will be personally meeting with this Committee later this week to discuss their plans and recommendations and to make certain that these plans and recommendations meet the concerns of the neighborhood, as they have been expressed to me.

I shall endeavor to keep you informed of the progress of this Committee in the ensuing weeks.
