IN CITY COUNCIL

August 15, 1984

- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Police Chief, Fire Chief, Director of Traffic and Parking, License Commission and the Public Works Commissioner to make the appropriate arrangements to allow John F. Kennedy Street to be closed from Mount Auburn Street to Brattle Street and the corner of Brattle Street, up to and including Brattle Square, from 9:00 a.m. to approximately 8:00 p.m. on Sunday, October 7, 1984 in order for the Harvard Square Business Association to participate in the sixth annual "Oktoberfest", (rain date of Monday, October 8, 1984); and be it further
- ORDERED: That the Chief of Police be and hereby is authorized to issue a permit for the sale of food, beverages and merchandise so that the Harvard Square Business Association can comply with the Massachusetts laws on the requested date; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the License Commission be and hereby is authorized to issue a license to sell wine and malt beverages by the cup; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to issue a sidewalk sales permit; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the Health Department be and hereby is requested to issue a permit for the sale of food and beverages outdoors.

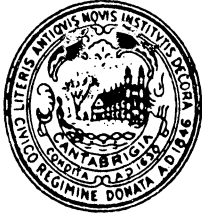

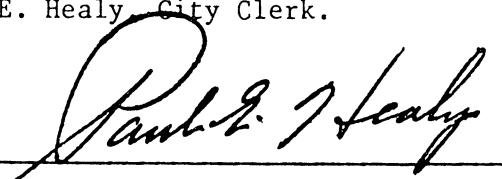
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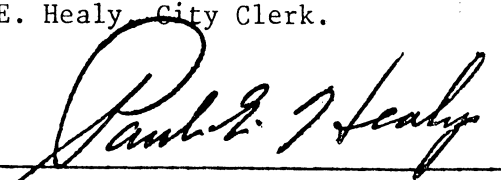

Dear Mr. Mayor and Members of the City Council:

The Harvard Square Business Association respectfully requests your permission to sponsor our sixth annual Oktoberfest this year on Sunday, October 7, from 12 noon until six p.m. (with a rain-date the following day, October 8, Columbus Day).

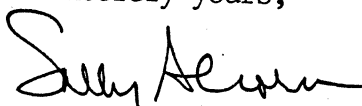
Traditionally, our Oktoberfest has necessitated closing the section of John F. Kennedy (formerly Boylston) Street from Mount Auburn to Brattle to automobile traffic from nine a.m. until cleanup is accomplished at approximately eight p.m. This year, we would like your permission to expand the area of the Oktoberfest to encompass both the prior section of Kennedy Street and the corner of Brattle Street, up to and including Brattle Square.

We have discussed increasing the area of the Oktoberfest with both the Director of Traffic and Parking and with the Chief of Police, who have helped map out the new street closings.

We will also be requesting a one-day wine and malt beverage license for some of our participants, as well as permits to sell merchandise and food at the Oktoberfest. As we have done in the past, we will provide outdoor security, entertainment, public facilities, and cleanup afterwards.
