MAYOR WOLF

WHEREAS: Under a new amendment to state law, builders are offered exemptions from some zoning limitations in return for including day care facilities in their buildings; and

WHEREAS: Another section of this amendment forbids cities from prohibiting or requiring a special permit for programs that wish to operate day care or afterschool programs; and

WHEREAS: The state is creating a "Child Care Affordability Scholarship Assistance Fund" for qualifying families; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back to this City Council regarding the implications of this new legislation for Cambridge.
