

## City of Cambridge.

In the year One Thousand Eight Hundred  
and Sixty-six.

### An Ordinance

in relation to the Bridge Fund and the Care  
and maintenance of West Boston and Canal Bridges.

As it is ordained by the City Council of the City of  
Cambridge, as follows:-

Sec. 1. The Ordinance in relation to the  
Fund to be received from the Hancock Free  
Bridge Corporation, adopted December thirtieth  
in the year Eighteen hundred and fifty-seven,  
the Ordinance in addition thereto, adopted  
July tenth, in the year Eighteen hundred and  
sixty-two, and the Ordinance providing for the  
Care and charge of West Boston and Canal  
Bridges, adopted March seventeenth, in the year  
Eighteen hundred and fifty-eight, are hereby  
repealed.

Sec. 2. The Notes of the City now held by  
the Commissioners of said Fund, shall be  
cancelled as of the twenty-eighth day of Feb.  
may last, being the end of the first quarter  
of the current financial year, and the other

assets now held by said Commissioners shall be merged in the funds of the City.

Sec. 3. The Superintendent of Streets shall, under the direction and control of the Surveyors of Highways, or a Committee of such Board, have the general charge of said bridges, in the same manner as of the other bridges in the City, and all expenses incurred for their care and maintenance shall be charged to the Appropriation for the "Care and Repairs of Bridges".

Sec. 4. The Superintendent of Lamps shall, under the direction of the Joint Standing Committee on Lamps, have the charge of the lamps and fixtures on said bridges, and of keeping said bridges lighted, in the same manner as of the street lamps and fixtures and of lighting the streets of the City, and all expenses thus incurred shall be charged to the Appropriation for "Lighting Streets".
