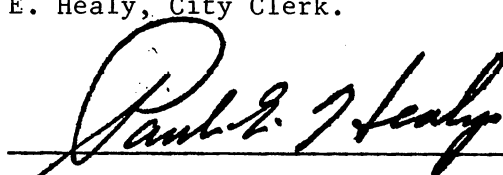
COUNCILLOR GRAHAM
