- WHEREAS: The lay-offs that have occurred over the last six months constitute almost forty percent of its labor force and there is concern that this lay-off is due to the Company's intention to terminate its East Cambridge facility; and
- WHEREAS: It is also my concern that Sultana Realty wishes to evict Borden Confectionary Company to facilitate the development of the property and building; and
- WHEREAS: If true, it's my belief that it is not in the best interest of the many people of various ethnic, immigrant and minority groups that are presently employed in the said candy factory; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to "muster" all department heads under whose jurisdiction this problem lies and to cause investigation and report back quick to this City Council before the unemployment among blue collar workers in Cambridge continues to mount.
