Ordered,

The Joint Standing Committee on Roads and Bridges, to which was referred the petition of P. J. Curley and others, praying for the acceptance of Bonnell Street,

Reply

That this street is not in a proper condition for acceptance by the city. The petitioners have filed a plan as required, and also, but one of, the owners have secured a release of the land. In order to put the street in a safe condition for travel it would be necessary to cut down the hill at Tuette Street, and to fill the lower end near Garden Street, and thoroughly gravel the entire street. All this would involve a large expense for which there is no provision in this year's appropriations. Your committee must therefore recommend that the petitioners have leave to withdraw.
