The request is for financial assistance to the amount of five hundred (500.00) dollars. This is to defray the expense of uniforms, and equipment as much of the officiating personnel are volunteer, as well as the cooperation of the Community Schoold for providing basketball courts.

The Fire department personnel on the Rescue have also provided an off-duty Emergency Medical Trained man in case of accident; as does the Youth Resources Bureau assist in

providing assistance in referees and contacts with youth
teams throughout the city.
