in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight.

An Ordinance,

establishing the Salaries of certain City Officers.

Be it ordained, by the City Council of  
the City of Cambridge, as follows:-

Sec<sup>t</sup>. 1. From and after the first Monday in  
January, 1859, the Officers of the City, hereinafter  
named, shall receive the following annual salaries,  
to be paid in equal quarterly payments, which shall  
be in full for all services rendered in their of-  
ficial capacity, viz:-

The Mayor of the City, twelve hundred dollars.

City Clerk, exclusive of fees established by law,  
eight hundred and fifty dollars.

Clerk of Common Council, one hundred dollars.

City Treasurer, three hundred dollars.

Board of Assessors, <sup>Eight hundred & fifty</sup> ~~one thousand~~ dollars.

Auditor of Accounts, two hundred and fifty dollars.

City Messenger, five hundred dollars.

Superintendent of Streets, nine hundred dollars; - of which  
sum, one hundred dollars shall be charged to  
the account of the Bridge Fund.

Superintendent of Drains, two hundred dollars.  
Superintendent of Lamps, two hundred dollars.

Justice of Police Court, <sup>twelve</sup> ~~fifteen~~ hundred dollars.

Chief of Police, eight hundred dollars.

Chief Engineer, three hundred dollars.

Four Assistant Engineers, one hundred dollars each.

Sec. 2. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances,  
inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.
