RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record urging residents who wish to take advantage of neighborhood sites for getting their parking permits and visitor permits to check the dates and times for their neighborhood site on the notice they receive from the Traffic, Parking and Transportation Department, or on the schedule that will run on Cable TV Channel 37 all month, or with the Traffic, Parking and Transportation Department.

E. Renewal by mail

1. Resident Sticker - fill out the attached application using one section per qualifying vehicle in your household. Please print legibly. Mail this form along with the applicable fee in check or money order. **DO NOT SEND CASH.** Include a current ComGas, ComElectric, Nynex, or cable bill dated for service at your address within thirty days of your application. This bill can be in the name of any housemate at your residence. The fee schedule is in Section D.

2. Visitor's permit in a household without a vehicle: mail a current ComGas, Com Electric, Nynex or a cable bill dated for service at your residence within thirty days. Mail the bill along with the applicable fee as described in Section D.

F. Hours of Operation: Regular office hours are 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. *For the month of December only*, we will open on Mondays from 7:00 a.m. to 8 p.m., and Tuesday through Friday we will be open 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

The office will be closed November 11, 1996, November 28, 1996, December 25, 1996 & January 1, 1997. Also, please note: December 24, 1996 we will be closing at noon.

G. Revocations: If a visitor permit has been revoked in the past, you will not be eligible for a new visitor permit. A request for reinstatement of visitor permit privileges must be made in writing. You will be notified in writing when a decision has been made.

Dear Resident:

This is to notify you that your current resident sticker and visitor permit will expire on December 31, 1996. We will begin issuance of the 1997 stickers and visitor permits on November 1, 1996. **In order to improve our services and shorten lines, we are encouraging residents to handle their renewals by mail.**

A. To qualify for a resident sticker: You must be a resident of Cambridge whose vehicle, weighing less than 2 ½ tons, is registered with the Registry of Motor Vehicles as principally garaged in Cambridge at your residential address. You must also present a current gas, electric, Nynex, or cable bill dated for service at your residence within 30 days. When applying at the office, please bring your original registration or a legible photocopy. The fee schedule is in Section D.

B. Leased or Company vehicle: This vehicle registration must indicate that the vehicle is registered in Massachusetts and principally garaged in Cambridge. You will also need to present a current ComGas, ComElectric, Nynex or cable bill as described below in Section C. The fee schedule is in Section D.

C. To apply for a visitor permit: You must present a current ComGas, ComElectric, Nynex, or cable bill, dated for service within thirty days for your residence. The fee schedule is in Section D.

D. Fee Schedule:

\$8.00 for initial resident sticker and one visitor permit
\$8.00 for each additional resident sticker in the household
\$8.00 for a visitor permit in a household without a car
NO FEE for SENIOR CITIZENS (age 65 or older)*
NO FEE for persons with either HP or DV plates*
NO FEE for persons with HP placard with the car in the same name*

***PROOF OF AGE OR A COPY OF THE FRONT AND BACK OF THE HP PLACARD MUST BE SHOWN. HP PLACARD MUST BE IN THE SAME NAME AS THE REGISTRATION.**
