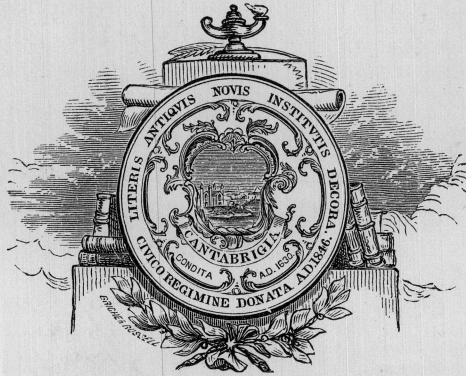


CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.



In Board of Aldermen, August 6, 1873.

Resolved, That the public convenience and necessity require that

Worcester Street
be widened
on the northerly side thereof,

by taking for this purpose certain parcels of land, as shown on a plan prepared by the City Engineer, and now before this Board.

Therefore, Ordered, that so much of the land on *the northerly side of*
Worcester Street
between Norfolk and Columbia Streets,

as is included between the ~~red~~ *black* lines shown on a plan of *Worcester St.*
Street, drawn by the City Engineer, dated *August 4, 1873*, and now before this
Board, be taken for public use, and laid out as a public way and a part of said *Wor-*
cester Street.

Ordered, That damages occasioned by said

be estimated
