- WHEREAS: There is a need for the City to provide to the general public, recreational access to the Charles River; and
- WHEREAS: The Massachusetts District Commission (M.D.C.) has a policy of leasing a great many parcels of land that front on this Charles River to private institutions and clubs for nominal fees and that: these institutions and clubs are not required to provide to the general public access or use of buildings or facilities that front the river on these parcels; and
- WHEREAS: On the Charles River Dam, there exists a building and parcel of land in this City of Cambridge on M.D.C. property that lies west of the Museum of Science parking garage that is being vacated by the M.D.C.; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City of Cambridge request the M.D.C. through whatever means available to lease this parcel and building to the City of Cambridge for an extensive period of time and for a nominal fee to house and field programs empowered by the City that would allow access for the public to recreational activities on this River; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager and all officers of the City be made aware of and reflect this position in the pursuit of this facility.
