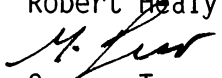

Subject City Council Order #23 Re: Accidents in the Vicinity of Dudley, Clifton,
Jackson, Clay and Montgomery Streets

The Traffic Director met with residents of the Dudley St., Reed St. Area at the Fitzgerald School on June 28, 1990 to discuss traffic problems in their neighborhood. The meeting was chaired by City Councilor Edward Cyr.

After listening to the problems the residents presented, I submitted a list of proposals that I would implement immediately, such as, adding stop signs, replacing old signs and a strict enforcement of vehicles parking too close to the intersection. These measures have been taken and I will monitor the intersections to determine what effect these changes have had on accidents in the area.

At the same meeting a member of the Cambridge Police Department was there and he stated they would be checking for moving violations.
