IN CITY COUNCIL

April 30, 1989

ORDERED:

That in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Code of the City of Cambridge, Chapter 12.08, Section 12.08.020, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to the Cambridge Family YMCA, for the purpose of conducting a display on the sidewalk at the premises numbered 820 Massachusetts for their Annual "Open House" Celebrations on September 18, 19, and 20, 1990 from 8:00 a. m. to 8:00 p. m. to distribute literature to attract new members, provided that no permit shall be granted to exceed more than twenty-five percent of the width of the sidewalk from the property line of the premises in front of which said display shall be installed and provided further that before erecting the above named display, the petitioner shall file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.), conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said display.
