- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that Lieutenant John J. Gallagher has retired from active duty on the Cambridge Fire Department; and
- WHEREAS: Lieutenant Gallagher was first appointed a firefighter on April 25, 1948 at which time he was assigned to Engine 8 where he remained until February 3, 1952 when he was transferred to Engine 7, an assignment he held until May 8, 1959 when he was transferred to Engine 4; and
- WHEREAS: Firefighter Gallagher was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant on March 15, 1967 at which time he was assigned to the Rescue Company where he remained until March 17, 1968 when he was transferred to Engine 1 remaining there until November 3, 1968 when he was transferred back to Engine 4; and
- WHEREAS: Lieutenant Gallagher had always been a dedicated firefighter throughout his entire 31 year career in the department; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our sincere gratitude to Lieutenant John J. Gallagher for his dedication to duty and to further extend to him our very best wishes for a healthy and happy retirement; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Lieutenant Gallagher on behalf of the entire City Council.
