ORDERED:

That the City of Cambridge, Massachusetts, U.S.A., hereby resolves to express our concern that Peruvian authorities have failed to acknowledge the detention of Mayor Hugo Atapoma, and reveal his whereabouts. As representatives of a freely elected municipal government, we believe that under fear of abduction or extralegal execution, no official can execute his/her official responsibilities. We believe this detention violates Article 9 of the United National Universal Declaration of Human Rights, which protects individuals from arbitrary arrest or detention. We urge you make known Mayor Atapoma's whereabouts, guarantee his safety, and if he is to be charged with a crime, allow him adequate legal representation, and to inform the Cambridge City Council of his condition.
