IN CITY COUNCIL
September 23, 1974

ORDERED:

That the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to International Food Service of 100 Charles Park Road, West Roxbury, Massachusetts to obstruct the sidewalk at the premises numbered 174 Hampshire Street (Prospect Street side) for a period of three months commencing September 20, 1974 during the construction of a new building; said obstruction to extend two feet from the property line for a distance of seventy feet of the above stated property line.

Said permit to be granted subject to the following conditions:

1. The contractor to restore existing sidewalk to the condition it was prior to the construction or to a better condition.
2. That no existing travel lanes shall be closed until authorized by the Director of Traffic and Parking.
3. That the contractor shall obtain a Temporary Street construction permit in addition to all other permits required by the City of Cambridge.
4. That the conditions having specified shall be subject to the approval of the Director of Traffic and Parking of the City of Cambridge, who may as he deems necessary require traffic controls or the use of policemen to facilitate the flow of traffic.
5. The contractor to file with the City Clerk a bond in the sum of \$10,000.00 indemnifying the City of Cambridge from any liability that may arise from the construction of said building during the period of construction.
